

# CCTV & Google Maps

1. You must Save the CCTV map to 'My Maps' before you can start to edit it...

2. Clicking on 'Create new Map' will bring up this panel which lets you add to the CCTV map

The zoom tool lets you zoom in for more detail, or zoom out for the bigger picture. You can use the scroll wheel on your mouse too

Use these buttons to switch between map and satellite view (currently showing 'map')
